## Have more time at home this spring than you were anticipating? Here are MBP's top tips for a tip-top spring:

## Tree Protection 101 - Wrapping

Use 4 - 5 foot tall\*, 14-gauge, 4-inch-or-smaller mesh wire, placed at least 6" from tree trunk. Leave no gap between bottom of wire and the ground. It can be helpful to anchor the wire to the ground. T-posts or croquet wickets make great anchors if need be.

\*Note: keep winter snow levels in mind when choosing height - we recommend at least 2' above snow level.

## Happy Spring!

Too many trees to wrap? Sand paint can be a good way to cover more trunks in less time - drop us a line for the recipe!
